Workshop Rules

1. Keystone's newly renovated Studio (801 County Line Rd, Store 10) is opened only when Keystone Art Supply is open. All questions regarding art classes or art products should be brought to Keystone Art Supply Staff.
2. The purpose of the Keystone Adult Art Workshop is to give artists maximum freedom for commissioned artwork, art leisure and portfolio preparation. The studio workshop is shared. You are free to work on your own art projects, but please be considerate of other artists or classes utilizing the studio.
3. Materials: Easels, tables and chairs are available for studio-public use. All other art materials must be provided by you. The studio has materials available only for its students. Should you need additional materials, Keystone Art Supply offers discounted art materials on-site and available for purchase. Under no circumstances may propellant based mediums or odorous chemicals be used.
4. You are responsible for your own clean-up. A small sink and clean-up materials are available for public use.
5. All in-house studio art materials and furniture are the property of Keystone Art Supply and may not be removed from the studio.
6. With freedom comes great responsibility! Keystone attendants reserve the right to dismiss anyone who is exhibiting negligent, disturbing or destructive behavior directed toward studio materials and equipment as well as other artists and their work. The offending party will be held responsible for any damages incurred due to such behavior. No refunds will be given.
7. Quiet background music will be provided during the workshops. However, artists are more than welcome to bring personal music players with headphones!
8. Please silence cell phones.
9. No food please. Bottled beverages are permitted.
10. No smoking. Many materials in the studio are flammable.
